

First Grade Expectations

Barley- Monday- Art, Tuesday- Computer, Wednesday- Music, Thursday-PE, Friday- Library

Orange Homework Folder- Comes home nightly and must be returned every day. Parents should remove any paperwork in the pocket labeled "Keep at Home". Papers in the pocket labeled "Return to School" need attention that night and should come back to school the next day.

Reading Briefcase- These briefcases come home nightly with books and keyring words for your child to read or practice. Math facts should be kept in your child's briefcase as well. Please be on the lookout for more news about our reading log homework calendar.

Dismissal- If your child's end-of-day plans change (riding a different bus, being picked up, walking home with a friend, etc.), you must send in a note or call into the office. If we don't receive a note or call, your child will do what they normally do.

The Basic 5- These are rules all 1st graders are held responsible for. They were listed in the class contract that most students have already signed and returned.

Illness- If your child is throwing up, has diarrhea, or is running a temperature, please do not send them to school. This helps make for a speedy recovery!

Homework

Reading Homework- Students must read every night that homework is assigned. Keyring words can be counted within their reading homework minutes. Reading Log Homework Calendars should be filled out nightly and will be graded according to the amount of minutes read.

Math Homework- Your child will have nightly assignments Monday- Thursday. They may have assignments on Friday depending on the topics being discussed and the amount of work they get finished during the week.

***** If your child doesn't complete assignments several times, an orange card may be given.**

***** Please make sure your child writes his/her name on all work. If there is no name, no credit will be given.**

Recess/P.E./Celebrations

Appropriate Dress- Students should be prepared for changes in weather. Layers may be a good option since our room temperatures vary. Flip flops are not encouraged. If they are worn, students will have to sit out of recess for safety reasons.

P.E. Attire- Students should wear athletic wear (no jeans) and tennis shoes on their PE day.
