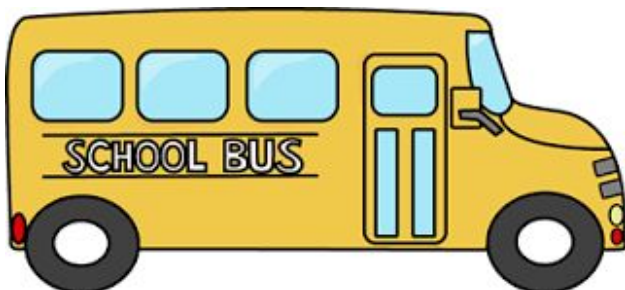

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

In order to make arrival and dismissal smooth for yourself and child, we ask that you read and follow the guidelines listed below.

ARRIVAL

If you are dropping off your child in the morning:

1. When entering parking lot, use one of the two right hand lanes which merge into one drop-off lane at the back of the lot.
2. Stay in the lane until you get to the designated drop-off area. Please drop your child off as quickly as possible.
3. If you are in a hurry, you may drive inside the gate making a u-turn to come back out. Your child can go through the side gate to walk into school.

If you are walking your child into the school in the morning:

1. Park in a designated parking spot. Please refrain from using the handicap parking spaces unless the vehicle is properly marked.
2. Always walk your child across the parking lot to the school doors.

DISMISSAL

Please park your car in a designated parking spot. Students will be exiting out the rear gym doors or the 5th grade hallway doors. Adults picking up child must be on the child's dismissal form and greet the teacher with child **INSIDE** the fenced area. The teacher may request a picture ID from the adult.
